

## **Indiana University Medical Physics Radiation Oncology Residency program Admission Requirements and Application Instructions Admission Requirements**

The Indiana University Medical Physics Radiation Oncology Residency program participates in the MedPhys Match program, administered by National Matching Services, Inc. on behalf of AAPM and SDAMPP. Applicants to the Indiana University Medical Physics Residency program are required to

1. have graduated from a CAMPEP accredited residency program not later than the date of orientation.
2. Submit all required application materials by December 1 of the year prior to residency program start.

Applications will be reviewed by the Indiana University Medical Physics in Radiation Oncology Program Committee (IUMPROPC). Selected qualified applicants will be invited for interview by February 1. All other applicants will be notified of their status for consideration by February 1.

The salary for the Medical Physics Resident (MPR) is determined annually by the Department of Radiation Oncology, but will be in the range of \$35,000 to the IU GME housestaff PGY1 stipend provided at <https://medicine.iu.edu/education/gme/employment-terms-benefits/>.
