

# **Indiana University Medical Physics Radiation Oncology Residency program Admission Requirements and Application Instructions**

## **Admission Requirements**

1. MS or Ph.D. degree in physics, medical physics, or related degree with an equivalent to a physics minor.
2. Clinical training, research/publication record, and CAMPEP accreditation of the programs attended will all be considered in the selection process.

## **Application Instructions**

1. Applications will be accepted during the month of October, via the AAPM , see <http://careers.aapm.org/>, Training Ads. All applications should be submitted through the AAPM.
2. Applications will be reviewed by the IU Medical Physics Resident Selection Committee during the month of November.
3. Phone interviews will be conducted during the month of December.
4. Invitations for on-site interviews will be extended during the month of December and scheduled for January.
5. Indiana University does not reimburse travel expenses for candidates electing to attend an on-site interview.
6. Residents will be notified of their acceptance status in February.
7. It is anticipated that the residency position will be filled by March for the start date of July 1 in the same calendar year.
